We invite you to start the weekend on Friday, October 20th by returning to 706 W. Ohio for the annual Alumni/Active mixer. The event will begin at 7:00 pm in the Chapter House Lounge. Following the meet & greet with the Actives, we will head down to the traditional Friday evening social gathering, allowing brothers and significant others to reconnect and catch up with each other. A round or two of "Jungle Pong" may be played as well!

Saturday will begin with the traditional Alpha Alumni Chapter Fall Business meeting in the dining area of the Chapter House. We anticipate starting the business meeting at 8:00 a.m. with our tailgate opening at the conclusion of the meeting. The tailgate will be in our traditional tailgate location on the northwest side of the Stadium. Saturday will conclude with the 2023 Homecoming Banquet. Based on some feedback we received last year, this year we want to try something a little different. Dinner will be at Biaggi's Ristorante Italiano. Please join us before the banquet for a hospitality hour. The dress code for this year will also be a bit more lax. We're opting for more of a business casual flavor. Dinner will be Martin Luther family style with our traditional program occurring during dinner. 


